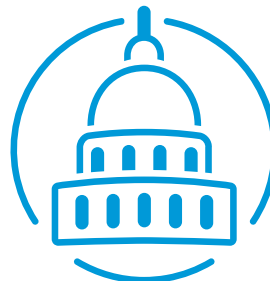
Our Mission
